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Consonant Sounds

g nearly as in English, but approaching to k. d nearly as in English but approaching to t. h k l m n q s t w y as in English. Syllables beginning with g except **Ꭶ**(ga) have sometimes the power of k. **Ꭴ**(go), **Ꭵ**(du), **Ꮦ**(dv) are sometimes sounded to, tu, tv and syllables written with tl except **Ꮨ**(tla) sometimes vary to dl.
